



BA3 Breathing Apparatus Wearer

Duration	2 Day initial training for new wearers / 1Day refresher for experienced wearers
Location	Classroom / Training facility
Delegates	Max 6 Students
User Type	All persons who may be required to use breathing apparatus within an industrial environment
Aim	To be competent in the use of specified breathing apparatus
Learning Objective	To be competent in the inspection, documentation and the correct use of the equipment . They will also be aware of all current UK legislation, which applies when using breathing apparatus. The student would be trained in hands on procedures in the inspection of equipment.
Method	A classroom seminar followed by practical inspection and use of specified breathing apparatus
Course Content	<p>Classroom Introduction to course content plus Objective and aims of course RPE Legislation, regulation and guidance notes. Selection of suitable and approved RPE Supervision of wearers in an industrial environment Manning levels for response teams</p> <p>Practical - inspection awareness with hands on training Pre use inspection and donning of escape breathing apparatus Pre use inspection and donning of entry breathing apparatus Pre use inspection and donning of airline breathing apparatus Removal and after use inspection and storage of apparatus Safe systems of work/ communication and control/ Rapid deployment Restricted movement and obscured vision exercises in BA galleries intended to represent a "beyond worst case scenario" for breathing apparatus usage External exercises allowing wearer teams to carry out spill control operations, line breaking, leak detection or other investigative work</p>
Examination	A written and practical exam.
Certification	On successfully passing exam and completing the practical training a certificate will be issued confirming the student has completed a BA Wearer Course including inspection and documentation of relevant RPE.
